Continuing education qualifications are as follows:

Renewal will be effective two years from the publishing of the rules for recertification of the CCS designation.

- A. CCS designate must accumulate 100 points over two years to renew designation at a fee of \$50.00 or retest. **CCS designates must maintain CCAA membership to qualify for this professional designation.**
- B. Points would be awarded as follows:
 - 25 points for attending a CCAA meeting
 - 50 points for a presentation at a CCAA meeting
 - 50 points for publishing an approved technical letter in the CCAA newsletter
 - 25 points for passing a 10 question quiz on an approved meeting presentation. (70% is passing)
 - 25 points for attending and passing a manufacturers/distributors training class or school. Subject to CCAA Board approval. Class syllabus must be submitted along with point count summary.
- C. Designee is responsible for submitting point count summary along with application to renew. Subject to review and approval by the CCAA Board.
